**FINDINGS OF FACT,
CONCLUSIONS OF LAW AND ORDER**

On October 10, 2007, the Arkansas State Board of Pharmacy (hereafter "the Board") conducted a hearing in the above-styled matter. After being duly served with notice hereof, Rick S. Hendrix (hereafter "Respondent") did not appear. From the testimony of witnesses, exhibits, and evidence of record, the Board makes the following findings of fact, conclusions of law and order:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent holds an Arkansas pharmacist license and is subject to the jurisdiction of the Board.
2. On or about May 2, 2007 in the Circuit Court of Sebastian County Arkansas, Respondent entered a negotiated plea of guilty to one count of manufacturing methamphetamine, a class A felony, in violation of A.C.A. §§ 5-3-401 and 5-64-401, one count of maintaining premises for drug activities, a class D felony in violation of A.C.A. §5-64-402, two counts of possession of drug paraphernalia with intent to manufacture methamphetamine, both of which are class B felonies in violation of A.C.A. § 5-64-403 and one count of possession of marijuana, a class A misdemeanor in violation of A.C.A. § 5-64-401.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Respondent's pleas of guilty to violations of A.C.A. §§ 5-64-401, 402 and 403 and A.C.A. § 5-3-401 is a basis for the suspension or revocation of Respondent's pharmacist license pursuant to A.C.A. § 17-92-311(a)(3).

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the pharmacist license of Respondent shall be revoked and that he shall not be eligible to reapply for licensure for thirty (30) years from the effective date of this Order.
