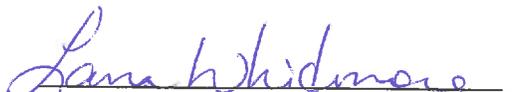
**BOARD ACTION**

Board inspector or inspectors will re-inspect Sexton Pharmacy unannounced no sooner than three months from today, March 30, 2016, and no later than nine months from today, March 30, 2016. Dr. Burgess seconded the motion. Dr. Cheryl. Bryant and Dr. O'Neal voted no to the motion. The motion passes 3 to 2.
