

Provisional Technician Registrations

Technicians – You are being mailed a letter this week that includes a fingerprint card. Your provisional technician registration will expire six (6) months from when it was issued, or December 31, 2020 (whichever comes first). It is your responsibility to get fingerprinted and return the fingerprint card to the Board's office. If your provisional license expires, and you continue to work as a pharmacy technician, you will be working in violation of Arkansas law. There are police agencies across the state that currently offer finger printing services as well as live scan services. If you are not able to find a place to get fingerprinted in your area, please contact the Board at (501) 682-0190

Pharmacies/Pharmacists – Please check with your technicians that have provisional technician registrations and be sure they are going through the appropriate steps to convert their provisional registrations into full active registrations. It is your responsibility to ensure that your technicians are fully licensed with the Board.
